# OKLAHOMA MISSION OF MERCY

Come join the OkMOM family & keep Oklahoma smiling!

Oklahoma Mission of Mercy (OkMOM) is an annual, two-day, free dental clinic designed to meet the needs of children and adults who are uninsured, under-insured, or simply do not have access to oral health care. Volunteers for the event turn a facility within a community into a fully functional dental clinic. Offering a variety of services such as cleanings, fillings extractions, root canals on front teeth, and limited ways to improve the smile line that addresses the most pressing dental need for the patient. There is no eligibility or income requirement. There are no questions asked or identification required, and individuals are seen on a first come, first-served basis during the allotted clinic hours and before the clinic has reached its maximum capacity. In addition to receiving free dental care, patients also have the opportunity to receive free dental education, vaccines and various health screenings. Over the past ten years, OkMOM has treated 16,138 patients totaling \$12,742,433 in donated dental care.

OkMOM needs approximately 1,500 volunteers, both clinical and non-clinical, to treat the anticipated 1,600 patients. Volunteers can work up to eight-hour shifts each day with very limited rest time. In order to treat as many patients as possible, treatment begins each day at 5:00 a.m. with patients continuously being treated; the clinic will be open and operating for 12 straight hours. During the event, breakfast, lunch and snacks are provided for all volunteers and patients totaling around 8,500 meals; along with thousands of bottles of water. Oklahoma Mission of Mercy is truly a community effort that addresses the growing need for oral health care in both urban and rural areas of Oklahoma.
